

Health Requirements, Physical and Dental Examinations and Immunizations

Illinois state law requires all students entering Kindergarten and sixth grade to have a complete physical exam with an immunization record. All kindergarten, second, and sixth grade students require a dental examination. All students entering Kindergarten and all students going into an Illinois school for the first time, regardless of grade, need an eye examination performed by a licensed eye doctor.

New students to the school no longer need a physical or dental exam (unless it is the Illinois mandatory school year) provided they can present a copy from their previous school for the mandated years. If their previous school was not in Illinois, their physical must contain all of the information that is mandatory on an Illinois Physical Examination form.
